



Top View

REQUIREMENTS FOR SUCCESSFUL INSTALLATION








DO NOT:Usedrywall screws to secure flanges to wall studs.

Product damage will occur and will void the warranty.

Entire bottom support must be in contact with a flat, level surface.


- 1.Read complete instructions before beginning installation.
- 2. Confirm that your model will fit in intended location and plumbing fixtures are located where required before beginning installation.
- 3. Walls and sub-floor must be solid, plumb, and square.
- 4.If installation surface is not level, use leveling compound or mortar bed for proper installation.
- 5. Use drop cloth to protect shower tray from damage during installation.
- 6. Two people recommended to install this product.




[★]Rough plumbing must be installed before shower tray installation.






- Do not install the product with any air gaps under the bottom support or product damage will occur.
- TIP: If installation surface is not level, use leveling compound or mortar bed for proper installation.





Plumber's putty will degrade shower tray material. Do not use plumber's putty to seal between drain and shower tray. Use latex/acrylic sealant or a gasket.
