

# River Stone Care Guide

## Cleaning Tips for Stone Sinks:

- Avoid using vinegar, lemon or any other acidic product on natural stone, except in specific cases.
- Avoid chemicals like household limescale removers and bleach.
- If you must use an acidic or chemical cleaner, apply a drop to a cloth and blot the stain, then rinse immediately.
- In case of stains caused by urine, vinegar or any other acidic product, blot immediately and rinse with plenty of water to dilute.

## Care of sensitive materials:

For sinks made of marble or other natural stones, use black soap or liquid Marseille soap with a sponge for daily cleaning. Avoid limescale removers and abrasive sponges.

## Cleaning solutions:

### Clogging by limescale:

- Use cooking oil mixed with a drop of lemon to gently rub the stone.
- Clean with a sponge soaked in hot water and a few drops of black soap, then rinse with hot water.

### Routine maintenance:

- Use a brush or sponge with a little dishwashing liquid diluted in water for regular cleaning. Rinse and dry afterwards.
- Natural stone soap is ideal for daily cleaning without altering the color or structure of the stone.

### Acid stains:

- In case of stains caused by acidic products, rinse immediately with plenty of water.
- For persistent stains, use a paste of Marseille soap and water, or consider a professional compressed air blasting if necessary.

## White spots:

- Use a cloth dampened with oil and white vinegar to remove white stains, often plaster or limescale deposits.

## Common stains:

- Clean with a damp sponge and white stone or clay stone.
- Use baking soda for stubborn stains, sprinkling onto a damp brush, then rinse.

## Resistant stains:

- Apply a fine paste of baking soda and pumice powder, let dry, then rinse.
- For heavy dirt, scrub with a solution of hot water and soda crystals, then rinse with clean water.
